

### **P** Vowels







Rule R vowels: Car for Sir.

> When r sticks to a vowel it makes a new sound.

What sounds can you hear in these words?

car for s<u>ir</u> h<u>er</u> p<u>urr</u>

er, ir and ur say the same sound. We call it the 'soldier' sound. **Hint:** The soldier salutes and says sir'. What vowel sound can you hear in 'sir'?

In American English a consonant r sound is said at the end of the r vowel. In Australian and British English no r is heard. Try saying these words both ways:

farm herd sir
